Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of G.5 Road from Wilson Drive to 26 Road was conducted on October 9, 2008. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-13 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2003 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical speed data. G 1/2 Rd. from has been improved and widened This section can now be traveled at 30 MPH. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

The speed limt on G 1/2 Rd. between Wilson Dr. & 26 Rd. shall be raised from 20 MPH to 30 MPH.
