Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of G 3/4 Road from 26 1/2 Road to and including Old Orchard Street and New Orchard Court was conducted on November 19, 2008. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-13 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2003 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical speed data. G 3/4 Rd., Old Orchard St. and New Orchard Ct. are all local residential street. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

The speed limit on G 3/4 Rd. from 26 1/2 Rd. to and including Old Orchard St. and New Orchard Ct. shall be posted 20 MPH.
