Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Summer Glen Drive from D Road to the end of roadway to include N. Forest Ln- S. Forest Ln.-Margo Ct.-Kathleen Cir. & C 3/4 Rd. was conducted on February 4, 2009. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-13 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2003 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical speed data. Local residential street, 28 ft. wide no outlet with curb, gutter and sidewalk and on street parking. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

Summer Glen Drive and all connecting streets to include, N. Forest Ln- S. Forest Ln.-Margo Ct.-Kathleen Cir. & C 3/4 Rd. shall be posted 20 MPH.
