Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Seasons Dr. from S. Broadway to Seasons Ct. was conducted on August 08, 2009. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-13 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2003 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical speed data. Entrance to the Seasons and all streets are local residential. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

Seasons Dr. shall be posted 20 MPH. All connecting streets within the Seasons shall be regulated at 20 MPH by the posting on Seasons Dr.
