Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of North & South Arriba Cir. from 23 Rd. circling back around to 23 Rd. was conducted on November 05, 2009. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-13 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2003 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical speed data. North & South Arriba Circle are local residential streets. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

North & South Arriba Circle shall be posted 20 MPH. from 23 Rd. back to 23 Rd.
