Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of Night Hawk Dr. from B Rd. to Black Hawk Wy. and Sun Hawk Dr. and all connecting streets within Hawks Nest Subdivision. was conducted on August 27, 2010. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 1995 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-13 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2003 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

No mechanical speed data collected. Area is under development and accepted. No existing speed limit signs. Posted for residential streets. Findings on file at City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Department, (970 256-4110).

Speed Regulation:

Night Hawk Dr. from B Rd. to Black Hawk Way and Sun Hawk Dr. shall be posted 20 MPH. All connecting streets within Hawks Nest Subdivision to include Black Hawk Way, Winter Hawk Dr. and Prairie Hawk Way shall fall within the 20 MPH zone.
