





Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate school zone for the segment of 24 1/2 Road from G Road to I-70 Overpass was conducted on August 3, 2011. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 6 section 615 Part 2 and Part 11, Section 1102 part 1 and 2 of the 2003 Model Traffic Code, section 7B.15 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2009 and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

School Zone Speed Regulation:

A reduced school speed limit zone has been established on 24 1/2 Rd. from G Rd. to the I-70 Overpass for the Caprock Academy. The reduced speed limit of 25 MPH shall be in effect during school days (Monday-Thursday) 7:15 AM - 7:50 AM and 2:55 PM - 3:30 PM.
