Background:

An evaluation to determine the appropriate posted speed for the segment of F Road from 24 Road to 24.5 Road was conducted on October 30, 1998. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Article IV, Sections 4-2 and 4-3 of the 1977 Model Traffic Code, section 2B-10 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Devices and the *City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards*. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in her opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

Speed Zone Study is on file at the City of Grand Junction Transportation Engineering Division, (970 244-1567).

Speed Regulation:

A regulatory speed limit of 30 M.P.H. shall be increased to 35 M.P.H. on F Road from 24 Road to 24.5 Road.
