

ORDINANCE NO. 691

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SALARIES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO:

Section 1. The following named officers and employees of the City of Grand Junction, shall receive not to exceed the following monthly salaries beginning January 1, 1946, payable at the end of each and every month, viz:
