Background:

An evaluation to determine the need for a school zone speed reduction for 29 Rd. from F 1/2 Rd. to G Rd. in the area of what is currently Independence Academy School (675 29 Rd) was conducted on September 9, 2016. That evaluation was performed in accordance with and pursuant to Part 6 section 615 of the 2009 Model Traffic Code, Part 7, Chapter 7B.15 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices 2009 and the City of Grand Junction Speed Evaluation Standards. The evaluation was reviewed by the Transportation Engineer and in his opinion is consistent with conscientious, reasonable and prudent traffic engineering standards and practices.

Findings:

29 Rd. from F 1/2 Rd. to G Rd. in the area of what is currently Independence Academy School (675 29 Rd) has experienced a time of day traffic congestion due to student pick-up & drop-off. It is necessary to lower the speed limit during these periods to accommodate the increased traffic and pedestrian activity.

Speed Regulation:

A reduced speed zone of 25 MPH on 29 Rd. from F 1/2 Rd. to G Rd. shall be in effect during school days from 7:30 to 8:30 AM and 3:15 to 4:00 PM.
