I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. Those present were Hearing Officer Michael Grattan, City Attorney John Shaver, and Deputy City Clerk Juanita Peterson.

II. APPLICATIONS TO RENEW LIQUOR AND BEER LICENSES

1. Dos, Inc. dba Dos Hombres, 421 Brach Drive, Grand Junction, CO 81507, Hotel and Restaurant

No one was present representing the applicant. The renewal for Dos, Inc. dba Dos Hombres was found to be in order and approved.

2. Thai Chili, Inc. dba Thai Chili & Pho, 2537 Rimrock Drive, Suite 700, Grand Junction, CO 81507, Hotel and Restaurant

No one was present representing the applicant. The renewal for Thai Chili, Inc. dba Thai Chili & Pho was found to be in order and approved.

3. TMPTF8, Inc. dba Rib City Grill, 2830 North Avenue, #C-6, Grand Junction, CO 81507, Hotel and Restaurant

Hearing Officer Grattan approved the Change in Corporate Structure.

Hearing Officer Grattan approved the new manager for GMRI, Inc. dba The Olive Garden Italian Restaurant.

 Western Colorado Latino Chamber of Commerce, "Business After Hours", located at 2635 N. 7th Street – St. Mary's Hospital Saccomanno Education Center, Grand Junction, CO 81501 – October 12, 2016 – from 3:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in the education center rooms 1 and 2, Malt, Vinous, and Spirituous

President and Event Manager: Jerry Martinez, 317 W. Ottley Avenue, Fruita, CO 81521

Jerry Martinez, President, was present.

City Attorney Shaver provided Mr. Martinez four documents, two marked with an "A" in the upper corner, one with a "B", and the last with a "C". City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Martinez to give him an overview of this event. Mr. Martinez said this is a business after hours gathering and due to it being by general invitation, State Liquor Enforcement encouraged them to apply for a Special

Event Permit for these events. City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Martinez if he has experience in these type of events. Mr. Martinez said yes, he has been involved with Cinco de Mayo for several years. City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Martinez to describe how incidental the alcohol service is to the event and how they will make sure they are in compliance with applicable law. Mr. Martinez said the alcohol is only incidental to the event and they have contracted with Fisher's Liquor Barn to handle the bartending for this event. Mr. Martinez said the event will only go from 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. but wanted to make sure they had time to get set up and clean up the event. City Attorney Shaver asked Mr. Martinez if there will be anyone under the age of 21 allowed. Mr. Martinez said no. City Attorney Shaver asked whose signature was on page 2 of Exhibit "A". Mr. Martinez said it was his. Exhibit "B" is outlined and shows a secure area and City Attorney Shaver asked if this the designed area. Mr. Martinez said yes and said the dotted line between conference rooms 1 and 2 will be removed for this event. Exhibit "C" just shows the diagram of the room and its location on the fifth floor of St. Mary's hospital.

Hearing Officer Grattan asked if there was anyone present in opposition of this Special Event application being issued. There was no one. Hearing Officer Grattan entered Exhibits "A", "B", and "C" (see attached) into the record.

Hearing Officer Grattan found that pursuant to Colorado State Statutes 12-48-106, there are no grounds to deny the special event permit, it would not be injurious to the public welfare because of the nature of the special event, its location within the community, or the failure of the applicant in a past special event to conduct the event in compliance with applicable law. He found that the application for a Special Event Permit submitted by Western Colorado Latino Chamber of Commerce, "Business After Hours" was in order and approved.

2. Horizon Sunrise Rotary Club, "Mesa Mall Fall Festival Beer Garden – 2016", located at 2424 Highway 6 & 50, Grand Junction, CO 81501 – October 15, 2016 from 10:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. The applicant is requesting approval of two different locations and has completed two different application packets. First location will be in the parking lot, between Cabela's and Sears. If weather is bad, they will move indoors to the area at "Clock Court". They will only use one location on this day. Malt, Vinous, and Spirituous

President and Event Manager: Miquette Gerber, 324 Dakota Drive, Grand Junction, CO 81507

Miquette Gerber, President and Event Manager, was present.

Ms. Peterson explained there are two applications, only one will be used, but in case of bad weather, they would have an alternate location inside.

City Attorney Shaver provided Ms. Gerber four documents, two with an "A" is the upper corner and two with a "B". City Attorney Shaver asked Ms. Gerber who prepared these documents and to describe the event. She said she did, and it is a Fall Festival at Mesa Mall. This is the second time they have been involved and it is a fundraiser for their club. City Attorney Shaver asked who will be there. Ms. Gerber said there will be club members and with 50 members, twenty-two have been through the City's Alcohol Server Training. They have also been involved with Pork and Hops in the past. City Attorney Shaver asked Ms. Gerber how they plan to contain the premise. Ms. Gerber said the outside boundary will have orange snow fence. City Attorney Shaver asked Ms. Gerber how incidental the alcohol is to the event and how ID's will be checked. Ms. Gerber said it is only incidental to the event, it is focused as a family event. The alternate location will be if the weather is bad. City Attorney Shaver asked to confirm they will only be at one or the other locations. Ms. Gerber said yes. City Attorney Shaver handed Ms. Gerber two documents marked with a "C" in the upper corner, one marked with a "D", and the other with an "E". He asked her to describe the area and who will determine if the event is moved inside. Exhibit "D" is the area near the clock tower in the center of the mall area and Exhibit "E" shows the overall area. She said the area will be secure with the orange snow fencing, only one entrance, and the ID's will be checked at a table outside of the event, just like outside.

Hearing Officer asked if there was anyone present in opposition of this Special Event application being issued. There was no one. Hearing Officer Grattan entered Exhibits "A", "B", "C", "D", and "E" (see attached) into the record.

Hearing Officer Grattan found that pursuant to Colorado State Statutes 12-48-106, there are no grounds to deny the special event permit, it would not be injurious to the public welfare because of the nature of the special event (it is a community event and fundraiser), its location within the community, or the failure of the applicant in a past special event to conduct the event in compliance with applicable law. He found that both the applications for a Special Event Permit submitted by Horizon Sunrise Rotary Club, for the "Mesa Mall Fall Festival Beer Garden - 2016" was in order and approved and reminded them that only one location will be used.

VI. OTHER BUSINESS

1. Hearing Officer Grattan recognized the remaining individuals in the room and asked them what item they are here on. Ms. Shay West said that Officer Scott Donaldson said the noise issue regarding STIX Bar and Grill would be discussed today. Hearing Officer Grattan said Ms. Peterson has given him and City Attorney Shaver emails that they were going to address under this topic. He said he hasn't had a chance to read them yet.

Also present with Ms. West were Linda Plunkett who is the manager of the apartments next to the parking lot of the establishment and Mr. Allen McQuivey who is a tenant.

Ms. West gave an overview of the issues going on with this establishment since the new ownership took over.

Ms. Plunket said the owners agreed to shut the patio area down at 10:00 p.m. for smoking, so now the patrons go out into the parking lot to smoke. She said they also said they would have someone at the establishment watching the excess noise and people. She doesn't believe that is happening.

City Attorney Shaver said he will meet with these folks after the meeting today.

Hearing Officer Grattan said he would like to have a review at the next meeting on October 19, 2016 of the noise issue. Ms. Peterson will contact the owner to have him be present. This will give all sides a chance to be heard.
