ORDINANCE NO. 725

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 638 CONCERNING COIN OPERATED DEVICES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 638 shall be and it is hereby amended, so that as amended, it shall read as follows:

Section 3. LICENSE FEES. The annual license fee for each coin-operated mechanical skill device shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and for each mechanical coin-operated music machine shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00). Such license shall be issued pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 638 and shall not be transferable as to ownership.

Section 2. The City Council hereby finds that a special emergency exists; that this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety and that it shall take effect upon passage.
