ORDINANCE NO. 732

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 594 CONCERNING REFUSE HAULING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 594 shall be and it is hereby amended, so that as amended, it shall read as follows:

Section 2. Application for such license shall be made to the City Clerk who shall issue the same upon payment of an annual license fee of \$25.00 for each truck or conveyance used or to be used for such purposes. Such licenses shall be issued pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 238 and shall not be transferable and shall not be apportioned or pro-rated for any fraction of a year.

Section 2. The City Council hereby finds that a special emergency exists; that this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety and that it shall take effect upon passage.
