

ORDINANCE NO. 738 a

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SALARIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO:

Section 1. That from and after January 1, 1947, the following named officers and employees of the City of Grand Junction shall receive monthly salaries in the following amounts:

City Veterinarian	287.50
City Auditor and Ex Officio City Clerk	275.00

City Treasurer	250.00
Judge of Municipal Court	225.00
Building Inspector	250.00
City Health Officer	80.00

Section 2. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. In the opinion of the City Council a special emergency exists and the passage of this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety and this ordinance shall therefore take effect upon its passage.
