


AGREEMENT FOR JOINT USE OF EAST AND WEST JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL GYMNASIUMS  
WITH THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION


In a joint governmental effort to provide public facilities for maximum use at minimum cost to the public, the City of Grand Junction has contributed \$19,729.00 to Mesa County Valley School District No. 51 towards the purchase of bleachers, basketball goals and lockers for East and West Junior High Schools gymnasiums. The city Recreation Department shall have access to the gymnasiums and locker rooms for the city recreation programs at a time in which the junior high programs, both academic and extra-curricular, have been completed. The School District will try to conclude their regular program by 6:30 daily. Schedules of special school events (socials, dances, concerts and parent/teacher nights) will be made available to the city Recreation Department by October 1, of each year for the period from October 1, through January 31, and by January 15, for the period from February 1, through June 1. Pre-scheduled school events shall take priority. In the event conflicts develop because of school schedule changes or events occur which were not scheduled, the District will make available a mutually agreeable substitute facility.

The East and West Junior High School gymnasium facilities will be available for city use during summer and Christmas vacations for which time the city Recreation Department will submit a schedule to the School District so the District can schedule housekeeping and maintenance programs to minimize the interference with the recreational program. The City of Grand Junction Recreation Department will furnish responsible personnel to staff these programs and will pay no maintenance charge for the use of the buildings. For recreation programs other than summer and Christmas vacations, the City of Grand Junction Recreation Department will pay a building rental fee on an hourly basis.

In the event major housekeeping or maintenance programs render the building unusable for a period of time, the District will provide an alternate facility for the recreation program. The City of Grand Junction will assume financial responsibility for damages resulting from the use of the facilities for the city recreation program, normal wear and tear excepted.

The School District reserves the right at all times to protect the property of the District. If in the opinion of the School District Administration it is necessary to assign an employee to the buildings during the periods of use by the City Recreation Department to protect the facility from excessive damage, the City shall pay a building rental fee on an hourly basis.
