**GRANT OF MULTI-PURPOSE EASEMENT**

Wesley D. Oakes and Penny S. Oakes, Grantors, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand FourHundred Fourty Six and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,446.00), the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, has granted and conveyed, and by these presents does hereby grant and convey to the City of Grand Junction, a Colorado home rule municipality, Grantee, whose address is 250 North 5th Street, Grand Junction, Colorado 81501, one (1) Perpetual Multi-Purpose Easement for the use and benefit of Grantee and for the use and benefit of the Public Utilities, as approved by Grantee, as a Perpetual Easement for the installation, operation, maintenance, repair and replacement of utilities and appurtenances related thereto, as approved by Grantee, including, but not limited to, electric lines, cable television lines, natural gas pipelines, sanitary sewer lines, storm sewers and storm water drainage facilities, water lines, telephone lines, and also for the installation, operation, maintenance, repair and replacement of traffic control facilities, street lighting, landscaping, trees, fill slopes and grade structures, as approved by Grantee, on, along, over, under, through and across the following described premises, to wit:

See Exhibit "A" for Riverside Parkway Parcel No. PE G-37B Rev, dated February 25, 2005, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto the said Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, together with the right of ingress and egress for workers and equipment to survey, maintain, operate, repair, replace, control and use said Easement, and to remove objects interfering therewith, including the trimming of trees and bushes as may be required to permit the operation of standard utility construction and repair machinery, the said Grantor hereby covenanting with Grantee that the Easement area shall not be burdened or overburdened by the installation, construction or placement of any structures or any other items or fixtures which might be detrimental to the facilities of Grantee and/or the Public Utilities or which might act to prevent reasonable ingress and egress for workers and equipment on, along, over, under, through and across the Easement area, the said Grantor hereby further covenanting with Grantee that she has good title to the aforescribed premises; that she has good and lawful right to grant this Easement; that she will warrant and forever defend the title and quiet possession thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.

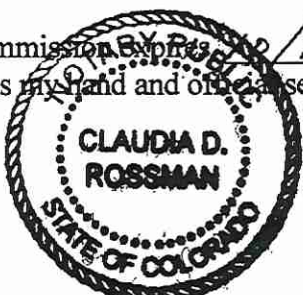

**PROPERTY DESCRIPTION**

A portion of the Mesa County Ditch parcel described in Book 12 at Page 420, Mesa County Clerk and Recorder's Office on June 1, 1887, lying in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 17, Township 1 South, Range 1 East of the Ute Principal Meridian, being more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the Northeast Corner of Section 19, Township 1 South, Range 1 East of the Ute Principal Meridian, (a #6 rebar with 2 1/2" illegible Aluminum cap), whence the Northwest Corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 19, (a 3" MCSM brass cap #1110) bears N89°40'49"W a distance of 1319.51 feet;  
THENCE N07°47'22"E a distance of 333.49 feet to the southerly line of a parcel of land described in Book 3657 at Page 78, Mesa County Clerk and Recorder's Office being the POINT OF BEGINNING;

THENCE N00°13'33"W a distance of 165.20 feet;  
THENCE N89°58'42"E along the northerly line of said parcel of land described in Book 3657 at Page 78 a distance of 14.00 feet;  
THENCE S00°13'33"E along the easterly line of said Mesa County Ditch Company parcel described in Book 12 at Page 420 a distance of 165.20;  
THENCE S89°58'42"W along the southerly line of said parcel of land described in Book 3657 at Page 78 a distance of 14.00 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Containing 2,313 square feet, (0.053 Acres), more or less, for a Multipurpose Easement to the City of Grand Junction for the use of City approved utilities as perpetual easements for the installation, operation, maintenance and repair of utilities and appurtenances including, but not limited to, electric lines, cable TV lines, natural gas pipelines, sanitary sewer lines, storm sewers, water lines, telephone lines, and also for the installation and maintenance of traffic control facilities, street lighting, landscaping, trees, grade structures, irrigation, road construction and maintenance.
