

ORDINANCE NO. 789

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION.

WHEREAS a petition to annex the property hereinafter described to the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, was filed with the City Clerk and considered by the City Council on February 23, 1949; and

WHEREAS the said City Council at that time found the said territory to be eligible for annexation, the petition to be signed by the required number of land owners, and all other requirements of Section 20f Chapter 314, Session Laws of Colorado, 1947, to be satisfactorily complied with; and

WHEREAS the City Council did accept and approve the said petition for annexation by its Resolution dated February 23, 1949; and

WHEREAS notice of the filing of said petition has been published once each week for four publications in The Daily Sentinel, the first publication being on March 4, 1949, and the last publication being on March 25, 1949; and

WHEREAS more than 30 days have elapsed after the first publication of the said notice and no counter-petition or written objection to the said annexation has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Grand Junction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO:

That the said annexation is approved and that the following-described property shall be and it is hereby declared to be annexed to the City of Grand Junction, Colorado;

Lots 13 to 21, inclusive in Block A; all of Block B; and all of Block C; of College Addition, Mesa County, Colorado.
