WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 1, 2017, 2:00 P.M.**

I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. Those present were Hearing Officer Sam Starritt, City Attorney John Shaver, and Deputy City Clerk Juanita Peterson.

II. APPLICATION TO RENEW LIQUOR AND BEER LICENSES

Patrick Trimm, Board Member/RMD Director, was present representing the applicant and answered a series of questions regarding the event location, security, and how it will be conducted lawfully.

Hearing Officer Starritt asked if anyone present was in opposition of this Special Event Application being issued. There was no one. Hearing Officer Starritt entered Exhibits "A", "B", and "C" (attached) into the record.

Hearing Officer Starritt found that pursuant to Colorado State Statutes 12-48-106, there are no grounds to deny the special event permit, it would not be injurious to the public welfare because of the nature of the special event, its location within the community, or the failure of the applicant in a past special event to conduct the event in compliance with applicable law. He found that the application for a Special Event Permit submitted by Powderhorn National Ski Patrol dba "Ski Swap – 2017" was in order and approved it.

2. Colorado Mesa University Foundation, 1100 North Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501 – "Great West Beer Fest – 2017" on November 3, 2017 from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., located at CMU Maverick Pavilion, 1100 North Avenue, Grand Junction, CO, Malt, Vinous, and Spirituous

Emma Leenerman, Coordinator of Alumni and Campus Engagement, was present representing the applicant and answered a series of questions regarding the event location, security, and how it will be conducted lawfully.

Hearing Officer Starritt asked if anyone present was in opposition of this Special Event Application being issued. There was no one. Hearing Officer Starritt entered Exhibits "A" and "B", (attached) into the record.

Hearing Officer Starritt found that pursuant to Colorado State Statutes 12-48-106, there are no grounds to deny the special event permit, it would not be injurious to the public welfare because of the nature of the special event, its

location within the community, or the failure of the applicant in a past special event to conduct the event in compliance with applicable law. He found that the application for a Special Event Permit submitted by Colorado Mesa University Foundation dba "Great West Beer Fest – 2017" was in order and approved it.
