## ADMINISTRATIVE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Project Work Plan is the work plan for this award. Performance will be evaluated consistent with the Policy on Performance Based Assistance dated May 31, 1985.
- 2. The recipient agrees to ensure that all space for conferences, meetings, conventions, or training funds in whole or in part with Federal funds complies with the Hotel and Motel Fire Safety Act of 1990.
- 3. Pursuant to EPA Order 1000.35, dated January 24, 1990, the recipient agrees to use recycle paper for all reports which are prepared as part of this agreement and delivered to the Agency. This requirement does not apply to Standard Forms. These forms are printed on recycle paper as available through the General Service Administration.
- In accordance with ERA's Program for utilization of Small, Minority and Women's Business Enterprises in procurement under assistance programs, the recipient agrees to:

a) Accept the applicable FY 1998 "fair share" goals negotiated with EPA by the State as follows:

If the recipient does not want to rely on the applicable State's MBE/WBE goals, the recipient agrees to submit proposed MBE/WBE goal based on availability of qualified minority and women-owned business to do work in the relevant market for construction, services, supplies and equipment.
