Champion of the Arts: The subcommittee narrowed the 49 submissions to the top 5. The Commission chose KAFM to receive Gilded Galaxy by Pavia Justinian for \$720. Presentation will be Dec. 3 at the Avalon Theatre at 3:00pm.
