HEARING OFFICER SAM D. STARRITT

I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. Those present were Hearing Officer Sam Starritt, City Attorney John Shaver, and City Records Manager Debbie Kemp.

II. APPLICATIONS TO RENEW LIQUOR AND BEER LICENSES

1. SINH, LLC dba Redlands Liquor, 2518 Broadway, Space B7, Grand Junction, CO 81507, Retail Liquor Store

The renewal application for SINH, LLC dba Redlands Liquor was found to be in order and approved.

2. Tequila's II, Inc. dba Tequila's, 2560 North Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501, Hotel and Restaurant

The renewal application for Tequila's II, Inc. dba Tequila's was found to be in order and approved.

3. Pester Marketing Company, dba Alta 6312, 107 Grand Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501, 3.2% Beer Off-Premises

The renewal application for Pester Marketing Company, dba Alta 6312 was found to be in order and approved.

4. Pester Marketing Company, dba Alta 6315, 722 Horizon Drive, Grand Junction, CO 81506, 3.2% Beer Off-Premises

The renewal application for Pester Marketing Company, dba Alta 6315 was found to be in order and approved.

5. Donaldson Properties, LLC dba Junct'n Square Pizza, 119 N. 7th Street, Grand Junction, CO 81501, Hotel and Restaurant with Outdoor Dining Lease

The renewal application and outdoor dining lease for Donaldson Properties, LLC dba Junct'n Square Pizza were found to be in order and approved.

III. APPLICATION FOR SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT

1. Delaney Donates, 2139 Texas Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501 – “2018 – Barney’s 1st Annual Cinco de Mayo Bike Rally” on May 5, 2018 from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Located at 2880 North Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501, Malt, Vinous and Spirituous

President: Wendy Reece, 2139 Texas Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501

Event Manager: Marcella Blandino, 2618 Foxglove Court, Grand Junction, CO 81501

Wendy Reece, President of Delaney Donates, and Marcella Blandino, Event Manager and part owner of Barney’s BBQ, were present to represent the applicant and answered a series of questions regarding the event location, security, and how it will be conducted lawfully.

Hearing Officer Starritt announced that since there is no one left in the room besides the applicants, no one was in opposition of this special event permit being issued. Hearing Officer Starritt entered Exhibits “A” and “B” (attached) into the record.

Hearing Officer Starritt found that pursuant to Colorado State Statute 12-48-106, there are no grounds to deny the special event permit; it would not be injurious to the public welfare because of the nature of the special event, its location within the community, or the failure of the applicant in a past special event (which were none) to conduct the event in compliance with applicable laws. The application for a special event permit submitted by Delaney Donates for the “2018 Barney’s 1st Annual Cinco de Mayo Bike Rally” was in order and approved.

IV. OTHER BUSINESS

1. An application for a Special Events Permit submitted by Colorado Mesa University Foundation, 1100 North Avenue, Grand Junction, CO 81501 for the “2018 - Western Colorado Community College (WCCC) Culinary Program Spring Dinner Fundraiser” was approved at the April 18, 2018 Liquor and Beer Meeting. The applicant is requesting the date be changed from May 4, 2018 from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. to May 3, 2018 from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Ms. Kemp advised the Hearing Authority that the representative for Colorado Mesa University Foundation withdrew the application for the "2018 Western Colorado Community College (WCCC) Culinary Program Spring Dinner Fundraiser" altogether. City Attorney Shaver asked Ms. Kemp if a permit had already been issued to the applicant. Ms. Kemp said no permit had been issued yet.

Hearing Officer Starritt accepted the applicant's request for withdrawal of the application.

V. ADJOURNMENT

The meeting was adjourned at 2:26 p.m.

- *I will have 7 Security officers at stand by inside and outside the facility as well as walk the outskirts

11. How will the conduct and level of intoxication of attendees be monitored and by whom?

I will have all three of Barney's B&B's manager/owner watching as well as bartenders, Security and Budweiser staff.

12. Have the volunteers or members of your organization been trained in the sale/service of alcohol beverages?

Yes. Barney's B&B's employees will be the only ones serving alcohol and all underwent materials training as well as a class hosted by the Liquor Enforcement Agency.

13. What types of alternate beverages and food/snacks will be available?

The Barney's B&B's menu will be running along with a focus Bar, non alcoholic drinks & water stations.

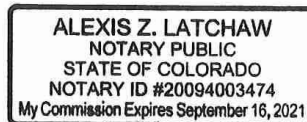

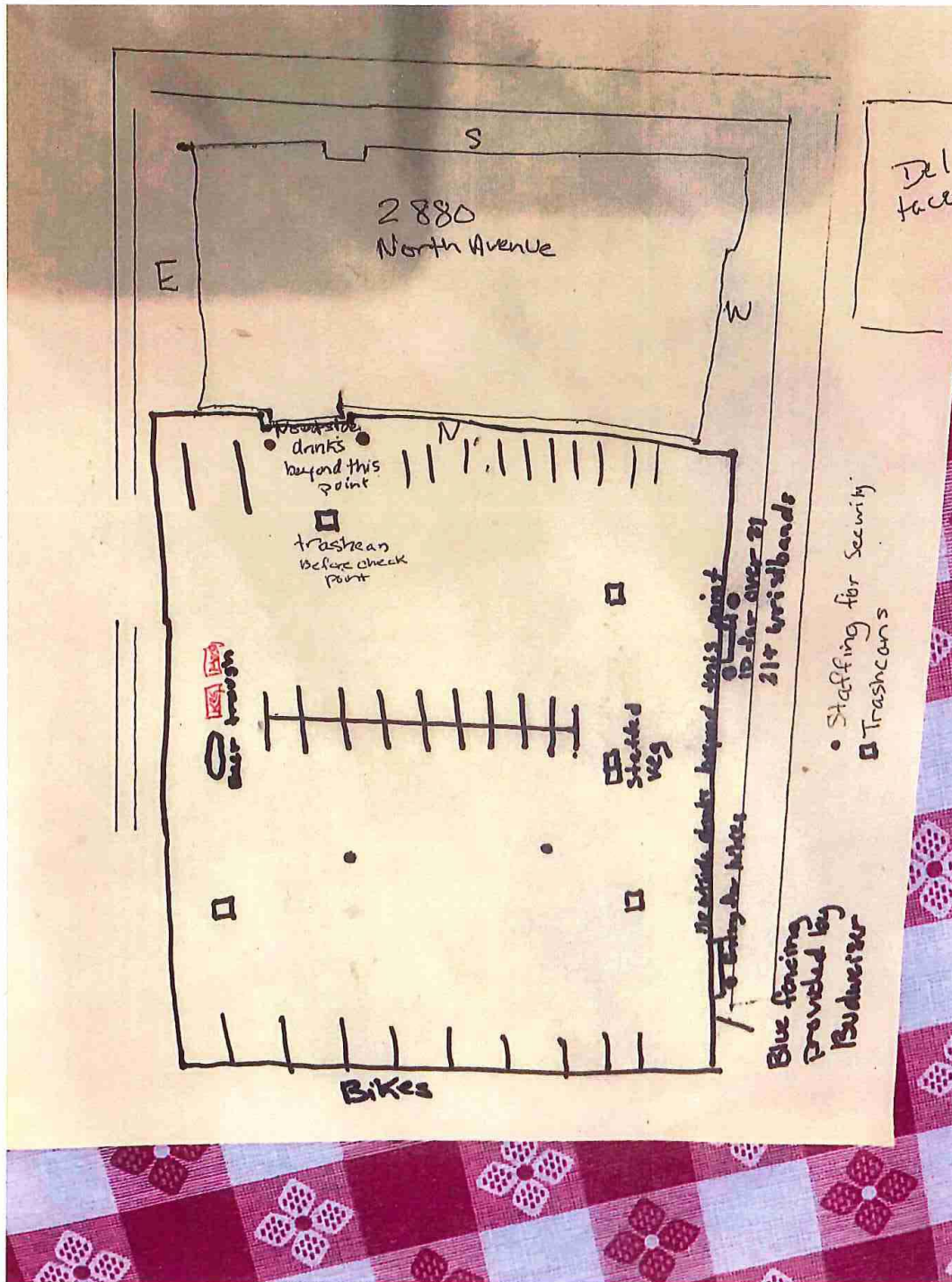
