II. APPLICATION FOR SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT

Director: Paul Watters, 2876 Victoria Drive, Grand Junction, CO 81504

Event Manager: Eric Copeland, 389 White River Drive, Grand Junction, CO 81504

Western Slope H.O.G. Director Paul Watters and Event Manager Eric Copeland were present to represent the applicant and answered a series of questions regarding the event location, security and how it will be conducted lawfully.

Hearing Officer Starritt asked if anyone present was in opposition of this special event permit being issued. There was no one. Hearing Officer Starritt entered Exhibits “A” and “B” (attached) into the record.

Hearing Officer Starritt found that pursuant to Colorado State Statute 12-48-106, there are no grounds to deny the special event permit; it would not be injurious to the public welfare because of the nature of the special event, its location within the community, or the failure of the applicant in a past special event to conduct the event in compliance with applicable laws. The application for a special event permit submitted by Western Slope H.O.G., Inc. for the “Grand Valley Biker Rally Pre-Party” was in order and approved.




