## Historic Preservation Board Regular Meeting

Minutes – March 7, 2017

Present: Chris Endreson, David Bailey and Ron Parron

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Chris Endreson at 4:00 pm at City Hall.

**Introductions.** New member Ron Parron was introduced to the Board. Ron owns a home in the North 7<sup>th</sup> Street Historic District.

**Historic Building Month.** The Board discussed potential ideas for activities in May. Chris indicated that there may be a home at 1002 or 1102 Ouray Avenue that might be a candidate for a Historic Preservation Award. David mentioned several events that will be happening at the Museum during the month of May and will provide Kristen with a list. Kristen will follow up with Palisade and Fruita to find out about events happening in those communities. Kristen will also follow up with Bob Silbernagel regarding a history column in the Daily Sentinel in May.

**Certified Local Government (CLG) Workshop.** History Colorado is offering a series of CLG workshops throughout the State in 2017. Chris Endreson may be able to attend the one in Meeker or Montrose and Kristen may be able to attend in Montrose as well. If not, Kristen will look into having the State CLG staff visit Grand Junction.

### Other Project Updates

- **Historic Building Markers.** The first installation on the Schiesswohl Building is scheduled for March 15, 2017 at 11:00 am. Four more are ready to be finalized. David reported that the committee hopes to install them in groups every several weeks.
- **DOE Cabin Project.** Kristen had provided the Board with a letter that included the DOE response to History Colorado comments on the 30% design that had been presented to the Board. The project continues to be refined and a 60% review is anticipated in the near future. The Board will be invited to review and make comment when it is available.  
Kristen will provide Ron with information concerning the design concepts so far.
