## **ADDENDUM NO. 1**

**TO:** All Offerors  
**RE:** Utility Conflict Verification/Potholing for Raw Water Irrigation and Waterline Replacement IFB-4587-18-DH

Offerors responding to the above referenced solicitation are hereby instructed that the requirements have been clarified, modified, superseded and supplemented as to this date as hereinafter described.

Please make note of the following clarifications:

1. Q. Does the City allow changes to the Contract Documents? If so, can those be submitted with bid documents?
  - A. No.
  
2. Q. Will the City help expedite excavation permit approvals to meet the accelerated delivery schedule?
  - A. The City can expedite its Work in the ROW Permit to within 24 hours if the following attachments accompany the permit application:
    - i. A \$10,000 Surety Bond
    - ii. A location map showing proposed pothole locations
    - iii. A Traffic Control Plan prepared by a traffic control company CDOT ROW permit will go through Utility and Special Use application.
  
3. Q. Time of Completion: Section 3.3.7 of the project specifications state 54 calendar days for completion. Section 3.7, IFB Tentative Time Schedule only shows 29 days. Please clarify.
  - A. 29 Days as stated in Section 3.7 is the intended time frame.
  
4. Q. Physical Verification: Section 3.2 states that utilities will be physically located. Does this mean methodology will be determined by Contractor?
  - A. Methodology is determined by the contractor. The potholes should not exceed 24" in diameter.

5. Q. Recording Top Elevation: To what level of accuracy does the top of the utility need to be recorded; GPS, Licensed Surveyor, Tape measure from top of ground? Please clarify.

A. Please provide location accuracy within 0.05'. The contractor may coordinate with City staff to survey locations.

6. Q. If the scope of work is to excavate several locations and fill them immediately, where will a hydrovac dump the spoils? Are depths of the utilities uniform? Are we basing the cutting on 2' diameter cuts?

- A. i. Depths are not uniform. Please review plan/profile sheets for anticipated depths.  
ii. Disposal of spoils is the responsibility of the Contractor.

7. Q. Are we working 5 days/ week or through weekends? 7am-5pm?

A. Work will be Monday through Friday, between the hours of 7 am and 5pm, unless the Contractor has written approval from the Project Engineer. Please also note Allowed Lane Closure Times. See attachment.

The original solicitation for the project noted above is amended as noted.

All other conditions of subject remain the same.
