ORDINANCE NO. 955

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION.

WHEREAS, a Petition to annex the property hereinafter described to the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, was filed with the City Clerk and considered by the City Council on March 7, 1956; and

That the said annexation is approved and that the following described property shall be and it is hereby declared to be annexed to the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

The East 70 feet of that part of the $SW_{+}^{\frac{1}{4}}NE_{+}^{\frac{1}{4}}SW_{+}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Section 13, Township 1 South, Range 1 West, Ute Meridian, lying South of the East Main Street Subdivision.
