

ORDINANCE NO. 960

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 83 OF THE 1953
COMPILED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GRAND
JUNCTION, COLORADO, AND THE ZONING MAP
INCORPORATED THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Chapter 83 of the 1953
Compiled Ordinances of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado,
and the zoning map accompanying said Ordinance be and it is
hereby amended by changing the boundary lines and designation
of districts as follows:

The North 72 feet of Lots 1 through 5 of Kennedy
Subdivision be reclassified from Residence "B" use to
Residence "A" use and that the balance of the Subdivision,
now unclassified, be classified for Residence "A" use.
