ORDINANCE NO. 990

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING UNBUDGETED RECEIPTS OF THE RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO THE RECREATION DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION

WHEREAS, because of the necessity for providing a supplementary lunch program at the Junior High School, the Recreation Department of the City has incurred a budgetary deficit of \$2,000.00; and,

That there be and there hereby is appropriated from the excess receipts of the Recreation Department the sum of \$2,000.00 to the Recreation Department to defray the budgetary deficit of such Department.
