

ORDINANCE NO. 992

**AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO INJURE, DESTROY OR REMOVE
PROPERTY BELONGING TO THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION OR
PERSONS IN THE CITY, WHICH ORDINANCE SHALL BE SECTION 43 OF
CHAPTER 37 OF THE 1953 COMPILED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF
GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND
JUNCTION:

THAT Chapter 37 of the 1953 Compiled Ordinances be amended by adding
thereto Section 43 as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully, maliciously, wantonly, negligently,
or otherwise, injure, deface, destroy or remove real property or improvements
thereto, or movable or personal property, belonging to the City or to any person
in the City.
