

**ORDINANCE NO. 1023**

**AN ORDINANCE INCLUDING FIFTH STREET, FROM NORTH AVENUE TO UTE AVENUE WITHIN THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO, INTO THE SAID CITY'S STREET SYSTEM.**

WHEREAS, the State Highway Commission of the State of Colorado has abandoned all portions of State Highway 6 on Fifth Street from North Avenue to Ute Avenue as a part of the state highway system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO:

That all portions of State Highway 6 on Fifth Street from North Avenue to Ute Avenue shall be a part of the street system of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, in accordance with Section 120-13-6, 1953 Colorado Revised Statutes.
