ORDINANCE NO. 1039

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 83 OF THE 1953 COMPILED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO, AND THE ZONING MAP INCLUDED THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Chapter 83 of the 1953 Compiled Ordinances of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, and the zoning map accompanying said ordinance, be and it is hereby amended by designating the district and changing the boundary lines so that:

South one-half of Blocks 75 and 76, the North one-half of Block 79, Lots 1-12 in Block 80, Lots 5-12 in Block 78, and Lots 13-20 in Block 77, be classified as Business "A".
