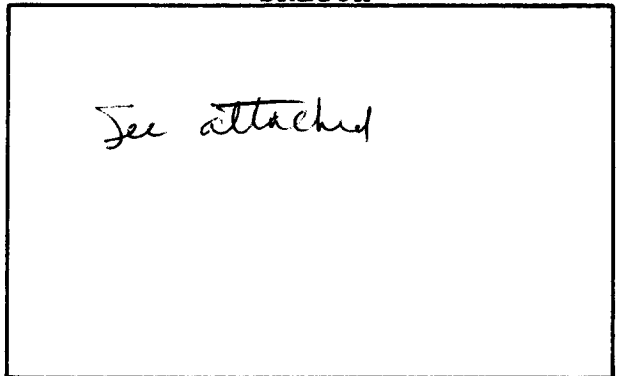

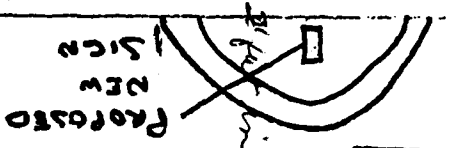

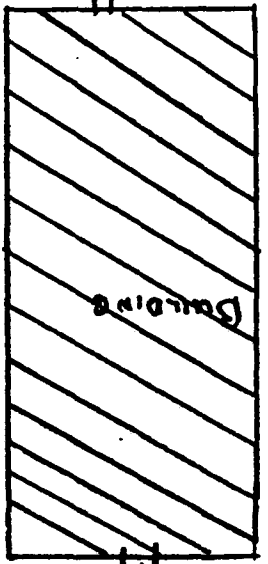

## Monolith (Free Standing) Signage

The monolith sign is in NCR Gray, with the illuminated logo in the NCR Red blocks with white letters. It is available in an 8' width and 4', 6' and 8' heights.

Monolith signage presents a highly contemporary, bold and easily recognizable means of identification. Monoliths are the preferred method of facility identification under NCR's new identity program, provided that the following site conditions are met:

- Adequate distance must exist between the building, roadway and the sign. Crowding or cluttered situations can lessen the effect and impact of the sign.
