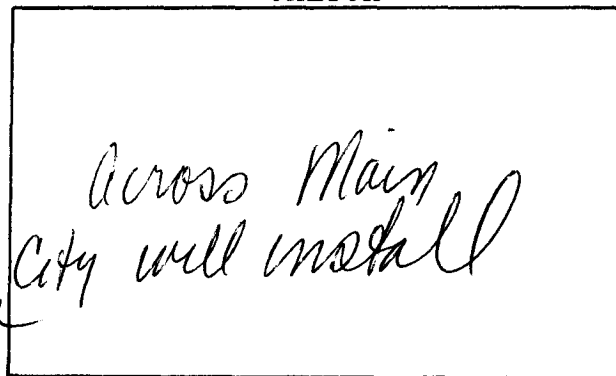

Dear Ms. Palmer:

As per our telephone conversation today, this Department has determined that the use of "U.S. West Communications" as the corporate sponsor on a street banner for "Prime Timer's Day" is not considered advertising. The emphasis of the banner is on the event; i.e., letters for "Prime Timer's Day" are 14 inches high as opposed to the 10 inch letters for U.S. West. The event is for the benefit of the community and historically, the banner has been allowed in the past.

A text amendment is being considered that should clarify this point in the future. Meanwhile, this letter serves as the reasons why the banner will be allowed.
