ORDINANCE NO. 1064

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a Petition to annex the property hereinafter described to the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, was filed with the City Clerk and considered by the City Council on September 17, 1958; and,

WHEREAS, the said City Council at that time found the said territory to be eligible for annexation, the petition to be signed by the required number of landowners, and all other requirements of Section 2 of Chapter 314, Session Laws of Colorado, 1947, to be satisfactoily complied with; and

WHEREAS, the City Council did accept and approve the said Petition for annexation by its Resolution dated September 17, 1958; and,

WHEREAS, Notice of the filing of said Petition has been published once each week for four publications in the Morning Sun, the first publication being on November 8, 1958, and the last publication being on November 29, 1958; and,

WHEREAS, a Counter-Petition has been filed against the annexation to the City, which Petition has been found to be sufficient; and,

WHEREAS, further action of the City Council is necessary to secure an election in the area proposed to be annexed; and,

WHEREAS, the sanitation conditions exiting in the hereinafter-described area are such as to require immediate efforts toward the solution of the problems giving rise to such conditions; and,

WHEREAS, annexation of such area to the City of Grand Junction offers the only apparent feasible approach to said solution; and,

WHEREAS, such annexed area will, upon annexation, require certain services immediately, which services are sustained, in part, by tax revenues which should be provided in some measure by taxes derived from the described area at the earlies t possible time;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO:

l. That the said annexation is approved and that the following-described property shall be, and it is hereby declared to be, annexed to the City of Grand Junction, Colora do:

All that part of Sec. 13, TlS, RlW, U.M. lying East of present Grand Junction City Limits, and all that part of SE 1/4 and SI1/2 NE 1/4 Sec. 12, TlS, RlW, U. M. lying East of present Grand Junction City Limits, and NE 1/4 ME 1/4 of Sd Sec. 12.

All that part of Sections 17 and 18, TlS, RlE, U. M. lying North of D&RGW R.R. right-of-way; the S 1/2, the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, and the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 8, TlS, RlE, U. M.; the S 1/2, the NW 1/4, the W 1/2 NW 1/4 NE 1/4, the W 1/4 E 1/2 NW 1/4 NE 1/4, and the S 1/2 NE 1/4 Sec. 7, TlS, RlE, U. M. except therefrom the following: Beg. at the NE cor of said SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 7, thence South 766.4°; thence N 58° 15° W 288°; thence N 59° 15° W 25°; thence W 260°; thence N 87° 15° W 165°; thence N 79°20° W 150°; thence N 72°30° W 500°; thence N 47°; thence S 72°30° E 100°; thence N 42°40° E 543°; thence East 856° to point of beginning; also described by perimeter as follows:

2. It is hereby declared that a special emergency exists; that this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and that this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
