ORDINANCE NO. 1113

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION

WHEREAS, A Petition to annex the property hereinafter described to the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, was filed with the City Clerk and considered by the City Council on June 1, 1960; and,

WHEREAS the said City Council at that time found the said territory to be eligible for annexation, the Petition to be signed by the required number of landowners, and all other requirements of Section 2 of Chapter 314, Session Laws of Colorado, 1947, to be satisfactorily complied with; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council did accept and approve the said Petition for annexation by its Resolution dated June 1, 1960; and,

WHEREAS Notice of the filing of said Petition has been published once each week for four publications in The Daily Sentinel, the first publication being on June 6, 1960, and the last publication being on June 27, 1960; and,

WHEREAS, thirty days have elapsed after the first publication of said Notice and no counter-petition or written objection to the said annexation has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Grand Junction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO:

That the said annexation is approved and that the following-described property shall be, and it is hereby declared to be, annexed to the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

> All that part of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 15, Township 1 South, Range 1 West, Ute Meridian bounded on the North by the North right of way line of West Main Street projected and on the West by the East bank of the Colorado River, Mesa County, Colorado.
