

ORDINANCE NO. 1233

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 25-14 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION BY ADDING THERETO A SUBSECTION (c), REDUCING CHARGES FOR CONNECTION TO THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION SEWERAGE SYSTEM FOR LANDS OUTSIDE THE CITY UPON AGREEMENT CONCERNING ANNEXATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO:

That Section 25-14 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Grand Junction be amended by the addition thereto of a subsection (c) which shall read as follows:

(c) The connection charges for tapping onto the City's Sewerage system outside of the city limits shall be at the same rate as for an in city tap provided that the owner of the land for which the tap is sought shall execute an irrevocable power of attorney designating the City Clerk of the City as attorney in fact to sign petitions for annexation of the said land to the City, either alone or in connection with other lands, at such time or times as the City Council may direct. Such power shall be recorded and shall run with the land and be binding upon successors in interest therein. Further such owner shall agree, as a part of such power, that he will not sign any counter-petitions to such annexation proceedings, which agreement shall also be binding upon successors in interest.
