ORDINANCE NO. 1284

AN ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION

WHEREAS, request has been made to the City Council of the City of Grand Junction to vacate the portion of road right-of-way hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, such vacation would not be detrimental to the City or the inhabitants thereof, and would permit a more orderly development of the area with which the right-of-way is concerned:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO:

That the following described road right-of-way, situate in Mesa County, Colorado, to-wit:

Beginning at a point which bears North 89° 53' West 100 feet from the Northeast Corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 7, Township 1 South, Range 1 East of the Ute Meridian, thence 130.9 feet along the arc of a 50 foot radius curve to the left, the chord of which bears North 14° 53' West 96.6 feet, thence continuing 130.9 feet along the arc of said curve, the Chord of which bears South 15° 07' West 96.6 feet, thence South 89° 53' East 50.0 feet to the Point or beginning,

be, and the same is hereby, vacated.
