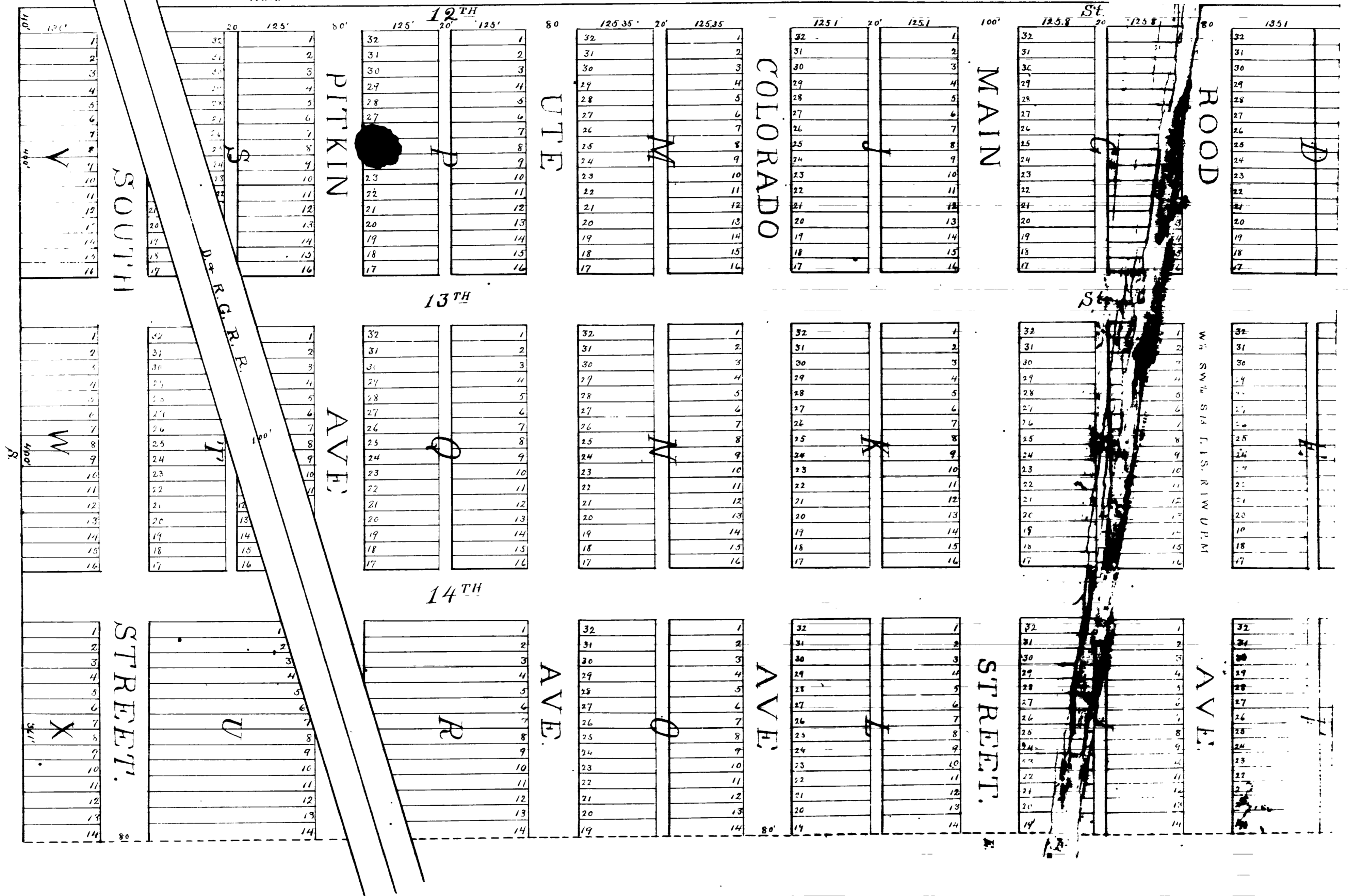


A PLAT OF KEITH'S ADDITION TO GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO.

Scale 1" = 100'

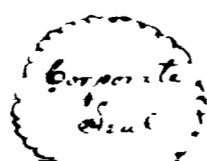
