## ORDINANCE NO. 1351

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION CONCERNING NEIGHBORHOOD BUSINESS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION:

That Sub-section (2) of the Limitations under Sub-section (8), under Sub-section b. of Section 3, Chapter 32 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Grand Junction, be amended to read as follows:

Section 3. ZONE CLASSIFICATIONS

b. Zone Districts:

(8) **B-2** Neighborhood Business

## LIMITATIONS:

2) Must be located at least 2,600 feet from another Business, Commercial, or Industrial Zone district in which retail sales are an allowed use.
