Time Capsule Information

In August, 2000 the city of Grand Junction buried its third time capsule, this one in conjunction with the grand opening of new city hall. The wording on the plaque covering all three time capsules is:

Time Capsules

Three time capsules containing articles of contemporary culture are deposited here:

September 21, 1957 A.D.
Grand Junction Rotary Club
on the Diamond (75th) anniversary of the city.

October 15, 1982 A.D.
Grand Junction Centennial Commission on the City's 100th Anniversary

August 26, 2000 A.D. Dedication of the new City Hall building.

All are to be opened September 21, 2032 A.D., re-sealed with additions and re-opened at each 75-year period thereafter.

Previous time capsules were buried in 1957 and 1982. The wording on the plaques covering those time capsules are respectively:
