

RESOLUTION NO. 3-75

OF DECISION ON APPLICATION FOR A HOTEL-RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSE BY BOSS BAR-B-Q, INC. FOR THE SMOKE PIT AT 2560 NORTH AVENUE, GRAND JUNCTION.

A public hearing having been held on May 15, 1985, on the application of Boss Bar-B-Q, Inc. for a hotel-restaurant liquor license for The Smoke Pit at 2560 North Avenue, Grand Junction, and the Local Licensing Authority having considered the evidence adduced at said hearing, FINDS:

1. That the hearing held on May 15, 1985, on the application was held after proper notice thereof under the Liquor Code.

2. The survey conducted by the City indicated that the needs of the neighborhood were not being met by other outlets within the neighborhood and there was a need for this outlet in that 122 persons so stated while 73 felt the needs were being met by the other outlets. Of those surveyed in favor of the issuance of the license, 26 were owners of property and 61 were employees. Of those surveyed who opposed the issuance of the license, 34 were owners of property and 32 were employees.

3. No one appeared at the hearing in opposition to the granting of the license and no petitions of disapproval were received by the Local Licensing Authority.

4. The characters of the applicants are good as determined by check done by the Police Department of the corporate officers of the corporate applicant and by letters attesting to said officers good characters.

5. The evidence supports the position that the license should be granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION:

That the application of Boss Bar-B-Q, Inc. for a hotel-restaurant liquor license for The Smoke Pit at 2560 North Avenue, Grand Junction, be granted.
