RESOLUTION NO. 5-85

OF DECISION ON APPLICATION FOR RETAIL LIQUOR STORE LICENSE BY SHERREL GENE GERSTLER FOR SPORTSMAN LIQUORS AT 740 PITKIN AVENUE, GRAND JUNCTION.

A public hearing having been held on June 5, 1985, on the application of Sherrel Gene Gerstler for a Retail Liquor Store License for Sportsman Liquors at 740 Pitkin Avenue, Grand Junction, and the Local Licensing Authority having considered the evidence adduced at said hearing, FINDS:

- That the hearing was held on June 5, 1985, on the application after proper notice thereof under the Liquor Code.
- 2. The survey conducted by the City indicates that the needs of the neighborhood were not being met by other outlets within the neighborhood and there was a need for this outlet in that 127 persons so stated while 83 felt the needs were being met by the other outlets. Of those surveyed in favor of the issuance of the license, 40 were owners of property and 81 were employees. Of those surveyed who opposed the issuance of the license, 29 were owners of property and 50 were employees.
- 3. No one appeared at the hearing in opposition to the granting of the license and no petitions of disapproval were received by the Local Licensing Authority.
- 4. The character of the applicant is good as determined by a check done by the Police Department and by letters attesting to his good character.
- 5. The evidence supports the position that the license should be granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION:

That the application of Sherrel Gene Gerstler for a Retail Liquor Store License for Sportsman Liquors at 740 Pitkin Avenue, Grand Junction, be granted.
