## RESOLUTION NO. 6-85

OF DECISION ON APPLICATION FOR A 3.2% BEER LICENSE BY WESLEY G. SHROYER AND DONNA K. SHROYER FOR D.J.'S CONVENIENCE STORE AT 2355 BELFORD AVENUE, GRAND JUNCTION.

A public hearing having been held on July 3, 1985, on the application of Wesley G. Shroyer and Donna K. Shroyer for a 3.2% beer license for sales in sealed containers for consumption off-premises for D.J.'s Convenience Store at 2355 Belford Avenue, Grand Junction, and the Local Licensing Authority having considered the evidence adduced at said hearing, FINDS:

- 1. That the hearing held on July 3, 1985, on the application was held after proper notice thereof under the Beer Code.
- 2. The survey conducted by the City indicated that the needs of the neighborhood were not being met by other outlets within the neighborhood and there was a need for this outlet in that 63 persons so state while 23 felt the needs were being met by the other outlets. Of those surveyed in favor of the issuance of the license, 20 were owners of property and 22 were employees or business lessees. Of those surveyed who opposed the issuance of the license, 9 were property owners and 8 were employees or business lessees.
- 3. No one appeared at the hearing in opposition to the granting of the license and no petitions of disapproval were received by the Local Licensing Authority.
- 4. The characters of the applicants are good as determined by check done by the Police Department and by letters attesting to their good characters.
- 5. The evidence supports the position that the license should be granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION:

That the application of Wesley G. Shroyer and Donna K. Shroyer for a 3.2% Beer License for D.J.'s Convenience Store at 2355 Belford Avenue, Grand Junction, be granted.
