RESOLUTION NO. 9-85

OF DECISION ON APPLICATION FOR A HOTEL-RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSE BY FRED M. ERWIN, JR. FOR THE LEANING TOWER OF PIZZA AT 2692E HIGHWAY 50, GRAND JUNCTION.

A public hearing having been held on December 18, 1985, on the application of Fred M. Erwin, Jr. for a hotel-restaurant liquor license for The Leaning Tower of Pizza at 2692E Highway 50, Grand Junction, and the Local Licensing Authority having considered the evidence adduced at said hearing, FINDS:

- 1. The hearing held on December 18, 1985, on the application was held after proper notice thereof under the Liquor Code.
- 2. The survey of the neighborhood conducted by the City revealed that 59 persons believed the needs of the neighborhood were being met by existing outlets, while 42 felt the needs were not being met. Of those who were inhabitants in the neighborhood, 96 desired that the license issue and 23 were opposed to the issuance of the license. The applicant offered petitions in favor of the issuance of the license signed by 171 persons. The petitions stated the needs of the neighborhood were not being met by existing outlets.
- 3. No one appeared at the hearing in opposition to the granting of the license and no petitions of disapproval were received by the Local Licensing Authority.
- 4. The character of the applicant is good as determined by a check done on the applicant by the Police Department and according to letters attesting to his good character.
- 5. The evidence combining the survey results and the petition of the applicant supports the position that the license should be granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION:

That the application of Fred M. Erwin, Jr. for a hotel-restaurant liquor license for The Leaning Tower of Pizza at 2692E Highway 50, Grand Junction, be granted.
