RESOLUTION NO. 6-86

OF DECISION ON APPLICATION FOR A 3.2% BEER LICENSE BY LOCO, INC. FOR LOCO #15 AT 722 HORIZON DRIVE, GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO.

A public hearing having been held on June 18, 1986, on the application by Loco, Inc. for a 3:2% beer license for sale for consumption off-premises for Loco #15 at 722 Horizon Drive, Grand Junction, and the Local Licensing Authority having considered the evidence adduced at said hearing, FINDS:

- 1. The hearing held on June 18, 1986, on the application was held after proper notice thereof under the Beer Code.
- 2. The survey of the neighborhood conducted by the City revealed that 38 persons believed the needs of the neighborhood were being met by existing outlets, while 24 felt the needs were not being met. Of those who were inhabitants of the neighborhood, 23 desired that the license issue and 14 were opposed to the issuance of the license. Thirty-one persons signed petitions supporting the issuance of the license.
- 3. No one appeared at the hearing in opposition to the granting of the license and no petitions of disapproval were received by the Local Licensing Authority.
- 4. The character of the corporate officers of the applicant is good as determined by a check done on them by the Police Department and according to letters attesting to their good character.
- 5. While the evidence as to the needs of the neighborhood is sparse, it would seem the establishment would serve a much larger neighborhood and the canvass of need within the neighborhood only would not be solely determinative. This is also supported by the petitions. The evidence supports the issuance of the license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION:

That the application of Loco, Inc. for a 3.2% beer license for Loco #15 at 722 Horizon Drive, Grand Junction, be granted.
