

RESOLUTION NO. 3-87

OF DECISION ON APPLICATION FOR A HOTEL-RESTAURANT LIQUOR  
LICENSE BY CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION FOR TWO RIVERS PLAZA  
AT 159 MAIN STREET, GRAND JUNCTION.

A public hearing having been held on March 18, 1987, on the application of City of Grand Junction for a hotel-restaurant liquor license for Two Rivers Plaza at 159 Main Street, Grand Junction, and the Local Licensing Authority having considered the evidence adduced at said hearing, FINDS:

1. The hearing held on March 18, 1987, on the application was held after proper notice thereof under the Liquor Code.
2. The survey of the neighborhood conducted by the City revealed that 264 persons believed the needs of the neighborhood were being met by existing outlets, while 269 felt the needs were not being met. Of those who were inhabitants of the neighborhood, 37 desired that the license issue and 11 were opposed to the issuance of the license. In addition, petitions were presented by the applicant with signatures of 134 persons requesting that the license issue as the needs of the neighborhood are not being met.
3. No one appeared at the hearing in opposition to the granting of the license and no petitions of disapproval were received by the Local Licensing Authority.
4. The character of the applicant is good as determined by a check done by the Police Department on the officers of the corporation applying for the license.
5. The evidence supports the position that the license should be granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION:

That the application of City of Grand Junction for a hotel-restaurant liquor license for Two Rivers Plaza at 159 Main Street, Grand Junction, be granted.
