

RESOLUTION NO. 7-87

OF DECISION ON APPLICATION FOR A HOTEL-RESTAURANT  
LIQUOR LICENSE BY AIRPORT QUALITY INN RESTAURANT, INC.  
FOR GOOD PASTURES RESTAURANT AT  
733 HORIZON DRIVE, GRAND JUNCTION.

A public hearing having been held on July 1, 1987, on the application of Airport Quality Inn Restaurant, Inc. for a hotel-restaurant liquor license for Good Pastures Restaurant at 733 Horizon Drive, Grand Junction, and the Local Licensing Authority having considered the evidence adduced at said hearing, FINDS:

1. The hearing held on July 1, 1987, on the application was held after proper notice thereof under the Liquor Code.

2. The survey of the neighborhood conducted by the City revealed that 54 persons believed the needs of the neighborhood were being met by existing outlets, while 71 felt the needs were not being met. Of those who were inhabitants of the neighborhood, 65 desired that the license issue and 13 were opposed to the issuance of the license.

3. No one appeared at the hearing in opposition to the granting of the license and no petitions of disapproval were received by the Local Licensing Authority.

4. The character of the applicant is good as determined by a check done by the Police Department of the officers of the corporation applying for the license.

5. The evidence supports the position that the license should be granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION:

That the application of Airport Quality Inn Restaurant, Inc. for a hotel-restaurant liquor license for Good Pastures Restaurant at 733 Horizon Drive, Grand Junction, be granted.
