RESOLUTION NO. 10-87

OF DECISION ON APPLICATION FOR A 3.2% BEER LICENSE BY MARKS'S MARKETS, INC. UNDER TRADE NAME OF GO-FER FOODS AT 102 NORTH AVENUE, GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO

A public hearing having been held on November 4, 1987, on the application by Mark's Markets, Inc. for a 3.2% beer license for sale for consumption off-premises for Go-Fer Foods at 102 North Avenue, Grand Junction, and the Local Licensing Authority having considered the evidence adduced at said hearing, FINDS:

1. The hearing held on November 4, 1987, on the application was held after proper notice thereof under the Beer Code.

2. The survey of the neighborhood conducted by the City revealed that 11 persons believed the needs of the neighborhood were being met by existing outlets, while 18 felt the needs were not being met. Of those who were inhabitants of the neighborhood, 49 desired that the license issue and 22 were opposed to the issuance of the license.

3. No one appeared at the hearing in opposition to the granting of the license and no petitions of disapproval were received by the Local Licensing Authority.

4. The character of the corporate officers of the applicant is good as determined by a check done by the Police Department.

5. The evidence supports the conclusion that the needs of the neighborhood are not being met by other outlets and it is the desire of the inhabitants of the neighborhood that the license issue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION:

That the application of Mark's Markets, Inc. for a 3.2% beer license for Go-Fer Foods at 102 North Avenue, Grand Junction, Colorado, be granted.
