RESOLUTION NO. 3-97

DECISION ON APPLICATION FOR A 3.2% BEER LICENSE BY PETRO-MARK CONVENIENCE STORES, INCORPORATED UNDER THE TRADE NAME OF "PETRO-MARK CONVENIENCE STORES, INCORPORATED",

LOCATED AT 502 GRAND AVENUE, GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO

A public hearing was held on April 2, 1997, by the Local Licensing Authority for the City of Grand Junction (hereinafter "City"), on the application submitted by Petro-Mark Convenience Stores, Inc., (hereinafter "Applicant") for a 3.2% Beer license under the trade name of "Petro-Mark Convenience Stores, Inc.", located at 502 Grand Avenue, Grand Junction, Colorado. The Local Licensing Authority having duly considered the evidence adduced at said hearing, FINDS:

- 1. The hearing on April 2, 1997 on the application was held after proper notice thereof, as required by 12-47-136 C.R.S., et. seq.
- 2. The survey of the neighborhood conducted by the applicant revealed that 94 persons believed the needs of the neighborhood were not being met by the existing outlets, 58 persons felt the needs were being met. Of those who were surveyed, 17 desired that the license be issued, 18 did not want the license issued and 2 were not applicable.
- 3. There were no counterpetitions or letters of opposition filed in regards to this application.
- 4. The moral character and reputation of the corporate officers for this applicant is good as determined by a check performed by the Grand Junction Police Department.
- 5. There are nine (9) 3.2% Beer outlets within the area surveyed. There are eleven (11) additional 3.2% Beer outlets within a one mile radius.

In light of all the evidence presented at the hearing, the documents and survey placed in the file, and the statements of counsel, it is determined that the statutory requirements for the issuance of the license have been met.

The evidence supports the conclusion that the needs of the neighborhood are not being met and it is the desire of the adults surveyed that the license be issued.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION:

That the application submitted by Petro-Mark Convenience Stores, Inc., for a 3.2% Beer License, under the trade name of "Petro-Mark Convenience Stores, Inc.", located at 502 Grand Avenue, Grand Junction, Colorado, be approved.
