## **RESOLUTION NO. 03-11**

## DECISION ON APPLICATION FOR A TAVERN LIQUOR LICENSE BY MAIN STREET MANAGEMENT, LLC UNDER THE TRADE NAME OF MAIN STREET SUITES, LOCATED AT 225 MAIN STREET, GRAND JUNCTION, COLORADO

A public hearing was held on January 5, 2011, by the Local Licensing Authority for the City of Grand Junction (hereinafter "City"), on the application submitted by Main Street Management, LLC (hereinafter "Applicant") for a tavern liquor license under the trade name of "Main Street Suites" located at 225 Main Street, Grand Junction, Colorado. The Local Licensing Authority having duly considered the evidence adduced at said hearing FINDS:

- 1. The hearing on January 5, 2011 on the application was held after proper notice thereof, as required by 12-47-136 C.R.S., et. seq.
- 2. The survey of the neighborhood conducted by the applicant revealed that 106 persons believed the needs of the neighborhood were not being met, 6 persons believed the needs are being met.
- 3. There are fourteen similar-type outlets in the surveyed area which are Fly'n Roosters, The Winery, Junct'n Square Pizza, Two Rivers Convention Center, Weavers Tavern, Le Rouge, Dream Café, Dolce Vita II, Nepal Restaurant, II Bistro, La Bamba, Suehiro, Blue Moon, and 626 on Rood.
- 4. There were no counterpetitions and no letter of opposition filed in regards to this application.
- The moral character and reputation of the applicants for this application is good as determined by a check performed by the Grand Junction Police Department.

In light of all the evidence presented at the hearing, the documents and survey placed in the file, and the statements the applicant, it is determined that the statutory requirements for the issuance of the license have been met.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF GRAND JUNCTION;

That the application submitted by Main Street Management, LLC for a Tavern liquor license, under the trade name of "Main Street Suites", located at 225 Main Street, Grand Junction, Colorado, be approved.
