Historic Preservation Board Regular Meeting

Minutes – August 7, 2012

The Board convened at 4:00 pm at City Hall.

Introduction of New Board Members. Two new Board members were introduced, Jodi Coleman-Niernberg and Joe Hatfield. Jodi is a downtown business owner and will serve as co-representative of the Downtown Development Authority along with Kevin Reimer. Joe owns a home and lives in the North Seventh Street Residential Historic District.

Minutes of May 30, 2012 Meeting. Jon Schler noted that the minutes for the May 30, 2012 meeting should reflect the Board's expressed desire to require the applicant to attend the hearing of an item under consideration for a Certificate of Appropriateness. Chris Endreson clarified that he was in attendance at the meeting. David Bailey made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 30, 2012 meeting as amended. The motion passed unanimously (7-0) on a second by Michael Menard.

West Central Historic Preservation Commission Workshop. Kristen let the Board know of an invitation from the Colorado Historical Society to attend a forum on Saturday, September 29, 2012. The State periodically hosts these events as an opportunity for training and discussing preservation topics with other communities.

50 Years of Operation Foresight Celebration. The Board reviewed photographs and other materials to be included in the display for the September 8, 2012 street fair. David Bailey stated that the Museum could provide a large poster of the original All American City sign. The Board suggested including some before and after photographs of various blocks of Main Street and some giveaway 1960s candy if possible. The Board will assemble the display at its September 4, 2012 meeting and members will cover the booth in shifts throughout the day as available.
